

Arrest of a Prolific Offender

- In a consolidated effort by multiple RCMP
 Detachments lead by the East Hants
 Detachment SCEU Aaron RICE was located in
 the Stolen vehicle. Aaron Rice was brought into
 custody without incident.
- Aaron RICE's offences spanned over a period of a year and included theft, vehicle theft, break and enter, possession of weapons and flight from police.
- He was charged and convicted on 65 CC charges from multiple jurisdictions.



 On 2024-09-12 East Hants RCMP received a report of trespassing / theft from the East Hants Waste Management Facility, they had the same individual captured previously on a trail cam heading onto the property. RCMP members from East Hants along with assistance from Indian Brook RCMP were able to locate the dirt bike and individual associated to the bike. A Nine Mile River man was arrested and charged with theft under \$5000 and possession of property obtained by crime. For his theft of copper wire








- On September 3, officers attended an illegal cannabis storefront in Mount Uniacke and executed a search warrant. Investigators located and seized approximately ten thousand grams of dried cannabis, items associated to the illegal sale of cannabis, and a truck and trailer.
- Officers arrested two men, a 33-year-old of Kentville, and a 29-year-old of Falmouth, when the search warrant was executed. The two are facing charges under the Cannabis Act, including possession for the purpose of selling and promotion of cannabis. Both men have been released pending upcoming court appearances.



"We located and seized cannabis products in bags and boxes that look like regular chocolate bars, candy, and cereal," says Sgt. Scott Macrae, Operations NCO for East Hants District RCMP. "Using branding and logos similar to familiar products means that these items could easily be consumed by kids who don't realize that they are eating a cannabis edible."
