Summary

The application process for the Flood Risk Infrastructure Investment Program (FRIIP) opened on May 2, 2024. The application deadline is June 13, 2024 and requires a resolution of Council, endorsing specific project submissions. Staff are proposing one (1) submission be made by the Municipality.

FRIIP invests in infrastructure and studies which reduce flood risks and community vulnerability. The program will fund up to 50% of eligible project costs. Eligible project types include river training and floodway improvements, floodwater containment and flood intensity mitigation, study work including mapping to identify flood prone areas, and identification of potential solutions to mitigate flood impacts.

Staff recommend submitting an application for "Flood Risk Mitigation Study - Paley Brook". This project has been approved to take place in this fiscal year.

Financial Impact Statement

Flood Risk Mitigation Study - Paley Brook, Budget \$50,000

Recommendation

Staff recommend that Council support the funding application for this flood mitigation study through making a resolution of Council.

Recommended Motion

Move that Council prioritize "Flood Risk Mitigation Study - Paley Brook", as the Municipality's priority for a funding application through the Flood Risk Infrastructure Investment Program for 2024.
