Subject: A White man slapped a Black man

Hello,

My name is Eberechi okwuwolu, and I hope this message finds you well.

On August 7, my football (soccer) team faced racism during a regional final. My team is 89% Black & brown & the opposing team is 100% white. All the officials are white and during the height of their racism, a white official slapped one of our Black players.

While we are tired of racism, we are seed carriers & for 500 years we have sown seeds. We want to do something that will not just end with this racist encounter. We know how to take hate, & we know how to transform our brokenness caused by hate.

The Genocide in Sudan has been ongoing for 17 months, and approximately 2.5 million will die of hunger by September this year.

We have committed to feeding 56 Sudanese families experiencing genocide and doctored famine, and this will cost us \$20,000. So far, we have collected \$1382.72, and we are hoping you can help as well.
